Location: North side of Town Square-307 East Reed Street.

Hours: 12:00PM-11:00PM.

Beverage Tickets and Wristbands locations: Beverage tickets can be purchased (cash or credit, cash encouraged) at the middle of the north side of the town square and middle of the south side of the town square. A wristband and beverage tickets are required to purchase alcoholic beverages. To obtain a wristband, you must be 21 years old and present a valid photo ID.

Admission: There is no admission fee.

Beverage Selection: Big Grove Brewery Tailwind (official RAGBRAI beer), Easy Eddie, and Citrus Surfer. Domestic Busch Lite, Busch NA, Michelob Ultra, Bud, Bud Light. Lime and Black Raspberry seltzer and an energy drink. (\$5 or 5 for \$20)

- No smoking allowed in the beverage garden area.

Campgrounds (Unregistered Riders)

Unregistered Riders Tent Campground: Non-registered riders are to camp in the north green space within the Evergreen Cemetery located at 1800 N. 8th Street. This area will also serve as overflow tent camping.

Unregistered RV Camping: We currently do not have any space available for unregistered support vehicles. Please do not park in any open parking lot areas as these are reserved for registered support vehicles.

Sag Wagon drop-off area: Drop-off will be at the main campground near the Information Centers. SAG wagon drivers will patrol route until 6:00PM. SAG Wagon is for registered riders who break down on the route. The SAG does not serve as a taxi service from town to town.

Rider Accident Bike Pick-up: Riders who experience a medical event or accident that requires transportation by a SAG vehicle or emergency vehicle during the route will have their bikes picked up by RAGBRAI. Those bikes, referred to as “med bikes” will be delivered to the RAGBRAI Information Tent in the main campground and can be claimed by riders or their emergency contact.

Other Information:

- Support Vehicle parking starts at 6:00AM.
- No RV dumping allowed in parks, parking lots, and campgrounds. See RV Repair and Dump section for RV waste dumping locations.
- Open fires are not allowed at any campgrounds.
- There is no electricity available for RV's, campers, support vehicles, etc.
- Once parked in the campground, you will not be able to exit unless it is an emergency. If you leave, your location will not be available upon return.
- Plan ahead and stock up on supplies before entering campgrounds.
- Ice will be for sale (8 lb. & 20 lb.) in the main campground. Look for the Hy-Vee truck.

RV DUMP AND REPAIR

Dump Stations: **One-way traffic please.** Head east on Highway 34 to Ironwood Ave. Do not turn onto Eastern Ave that runs east of the hospital as a short cut. This road needs to remain open for ambulance and employee traffic. Turn left (north) on Ironwood, turn left (west) on 190th Street. This turns into Ratliff. Turn left (south) on 8th Street. There will be two dump stations available here on 8th Street. After you have dumped, proceed south on 8th street to Senate. Turn left on Senate to stop sign at the top of the hill. Turn right on Eastern. Proceed to Highway 34 to hit support vehicle route out.

Alternate Dump Station: **One-way traffic please.** 414 West Bridge Street. Enter Bridge Street from Broadway (Highway 48). Dump station will be on the south side of Bridge Street. After you have dumped, proceed forward to the first road that goes right. You will meet up with 200th Street. Turn right on 200th Street to stoplight. Turn left and proceed to Highway 34. Turn right to hit support vehicle route out. **Note:** To avoid heavy bike traffic, it is advised you use the main dumping station above.

RV repair: I-29 Repair located along Interstate 29 (34 mi west of Red Oak). 712-622-8120.

SAG WAGON

RAGBRAI Sag Wagon will drop off in the main campground as close to the Information Center as possible. Riders who break down on the route are picked up by one of four Sag Wagons. Sag Wagon drivers patrol the route until 6:00PM. Sag Wagons do not provide taxi services from town to town.

SHOWERS

Showers: Showers will be located inside the high school, shower trailers far northeast parking lot and east of the football field (all at main campground), swimming pool, and at the 4th & Oak Car Wash. Price range is \$5.00-\$10.00 depending on location.

Shower Hours: 9:00AM-9:00PM main campground. Swimming pool shower hours are 12:00PM-11:00PM. Car wash hours are 10:00AM-10:00PM.

WEATHER

MONITORING WEATHER CONDITIONS

Area Command/Emergency Operations Center, in cooperation with the National Weather Service, will monitor weather conditions during the time RAGBRAI participants are in Montgomery County. The Command Post will make appropriate notifications of weather watches and warnings when such conditions occur.

RAGBRAI participants are encouraged to sign up for free severe weather alerts and emergency notifications from local jurisdictions across the entire state during the event through AlertIowa and the Smart911app.



Look for this symbol on the map for the emergency shelter closest to you.

DEFINITIONS

A Severe Weather **WATCH** means that conditions are favorable for the formation of severe weather. Preparations should be made to protect yourself and others around you. An announcement regarding the weather watch will be made at the event stage.

A Severe Weather **WARNING** means that a severe thunderstorm, dangerous hail or a tornado has been spotted in the area.

- An announcement will be made at the RAGBRAI stage area of the severe weather warning and people will be directed to move into designated shelter areas.
- Law enforcement assigned to the area will be notified of the severe weather warning and directed to use any available vehicle public address systems to announce the following warning: **“A Severe Thunderstorm Warning (or Tornado Warning) has been issued for this area. You should immediately move to the (designated shelter in that area) and take shelter”**.
- Designated shelter locations will have signs placed outside of main entrance doors for easy identification and access.
- The outdoor warning sirens in the impacted area shall be activated using the normal activation procedures with the direction of Area Command/EMA.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: Where can I camp?

A: Main campground and parks are reserved for registered riders, charters and groups only. The main campground is located at the Jr.-Sr. High School at 2011 N. 8th Street. Non-registered riders are to camp in the north green space within the Evergreen Cemetery located at 1800 N. 8th Street. This area will also serve as overflow tent camping.

Q: Where is the RAGBRAI Campground Information tent, lost and found, and day passes?

A: 2011 N. 8th Street-Main Campground area.

Q: Where is the RAGBRAI ® Merchandise trailer located?

A: Downtown SE corner at 1st and Coolbaugh.

Q: Where are the bike vendors?

A: RAGBRAI Bike Shops will be located on the southwest corner of the Square on Coolbaugh between 2nd and 3rd Street.

Q: Where do the SAG Wagons unload?

A: Main Campground as close to Information center as possible.

Q: Where are the baggage trucks?

A: Main Campground.

Q: Where are the first aid tents located?

A: Main campground inside the school and northwest corner of the Town Square.

Q: Where are the food vendors?

A: Main Campground and Downtown proper.

Q: Where is the main entertainment area?

A: Downtown Square.

Q: Where is the message board located?

A: Main Campground next to the Red Oak Information Center tent.

Q: Where is the bike route out of town?

A: Head north on 4th street to Ratliff, turn left on Ratliff, then right on Highway 48. See tear-off maps or scan Info QR codes.

Q: Where does the nearest shuttle stop from the Main Campground

A: Southeast corner of the Jr.-Sr. high school parking lot.

Q: Where are the nearest places from the Main Campground to eat besides food vendors?

A: McDonalds, Burger King, Subway, Hy-Vee, and Pizza Ranch, KFC/Taco Bell.

Q: How late will the showers be open?

A: 9:00PM in the Main Campground. 11:00PM at the Swimming Pool. 10:00PM at the car wash.

Q: What time does the beer garden open and entertainment start?

A: 12:00PM

Q: Where can I get my beer garden wristband and buy tickets?

A: Middle of the north side of the town square and middle of the south side of the town square.

Q: Where can I buy ice?

A: Hy-Vee truck at the main campground. Five One 8 downtown square. Grocery and convenience stores.

Q: Where is Public Wi-Fi available?

A: In the vicinity of the public library located at 400 N. 2nd Street, use guest wi-fi poplguest. There is no password required.

Q: Where can I get my RV fixed?

A: I-29 Repair at 57088 190th Street in Pacific Junction is more than happy to assist with any RV problems that should arise.
